## **Gym Kit**

The Scottish Government has a clear policy on pupils taking part in two hours of meaningful Physical Education in school each week.

It is vital that your child has appropriate clothing and footwear to wear during these sessions. This includes shorts, t-shirt, gym shoes. We actively encourage children to wear gym shoes rather than trainers. However, we do appreciate that for some children trainers are the only option.

Children must also have a water bottle to keep hydrated. All items of jewellery must be removed. If your child has recently had their ears pierced, parents must provide tape to cover their ears and children must be able to apply this themselves.

All items of clothing and belongs *must* be clearly marked with your child's name.



# **ParentPay**


